<p>What is my username and password?</p>	<p>Username is firstname/lastname/last three digits of studentID (Ex. garyallen456@riversideunified.org) Initial Password is Welcome1. You will be prompted for a new password once logged in.</p>
<p>Logging into my Chromebook</p>	<p>RUSD Chromebooks will be used to engage with your teacher and classmates for instruction. One Pager, English and Spanish.</p>
<p>Accessing Student Email Account </p>	<p>Student email accounts can be accessed through www.gmail.com using the same login information above. Students in grades Preschool through 8th grade are limited to receiving emails from inside the District and only approved senders outside of the District for their safety.</p>
<p>Aeries Parent Portal </p>	<p>RUSD's secure school database for student information. New user set up guide Aeries resource webpage *If you did not receive a verification code upon enrollment, contact your school administrator.</p>
<p>Finding out my child's teacher(s)</p>	<p>Grades TK-6: Assignments will be posted on the school website 8/7-8/10. Grades 7-12: Access class schedule through Aeries</p>
<p>Logging into Clever</p>	<p>Clever is your child's personalized portal to all online learning tools. Video tutorial</p>
<p>Google Classroom </p>	<p>Teachers use Google Classroom to share assignments, resources, homework and much more with students and parents. Video and print guides</p>
<p>What do I do on the first day of school?</p>	<p>On August 10, 2020, your child should log into their Google Classroom to find instructions and a schedule of activities from your teacher(s).</p>
<p>Picking up Textbooks and Materials</p>	<p>Student materials will be available for pick up the week of August 17, 2020. Please look for communication from your school for your assigned time.</p>
